Welcome and President's Report:

Hillary updated the committee on the work the of new Wolfhound Grade Representatives over the summer and into the school year.

Shannon reported the approximate profit for the logo wear pre-sale was \$1,680.00 and previewed some of the new logo wear items.

Stephanie Goldfine reported that the committee budget will be similar to the 2018-2019 school year. She will present the 2019-2020 budget at the November Executive Committee meeting.

Karon Harden made an addition to the calendar. The Community Conversation scheduled on October 24, 2019 at 6:30 PM will discuss talking about gender issues.

Head of School Report

Peter welcomed the committee and reported that the school opening has gone very well. This year St. Patrick's welcomes 87 new students, 44 new families. The Nursery School includes 36 new students, Lower School welcomes 33, and the Upper School has 18 new students. Peter reported that the first event, Opening Chapel, was very well attended.

Peter's construction report included the exciting completion of the Sports Deck and celebrated meeting the deadline. Peter noted the PA's contribution of \$1,609.78 for the Sports Deck equipment. Green and White Night will be held on the Sports Deck, giving parents the opportunity to enjoy the new space.

The Spector-White Primary Grades Playground is undergoing slope-stabilization work including retaining walls, stormwater-management, and landscaping. As this work on the playground is nearing completion, the East Lot parking area is undergoing repaving which will allow for additional parking in this popular parking lot.

Additionally, the Infant-Toddler Center (ITC) was opened to families beyond faculty and staff. By year's end, the ITC will have 21 students enrolled, four of them children of teachers/educators from outside the St. Patrick's community. The hope is to enlarge the ITC and continue this trend.
